

## Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Moss Landing Inc (“the Farm”) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the Farm cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) or guests will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, you and your child(ren)’s or guests’ participation in activities before, during and after summer horse camp and other activities at the Farm could increase your risk and your child(ren)’s and guests’ risk of contracting COVID-19.

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By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and guests and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending camp and other activities at the Farm and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.


I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Farm may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Farm employees, volunteers, instructors and program participants and their families.


I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or guests or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense), of any kind, that I or my child(ren) or guests may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)’s or guests’ attendance at the Farm or participation in Farm activities (“Claims”).

On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Farm, its owners, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto.

I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Farm, its owners, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any Farm activity.

- o Please keep up to date with the **Centers for Disease Control Guidance**, which includes best practices during this time.
- o We are not currently taking morning temps or requiring masks, but be advised that we will follow health updates and COVID-19 recommendations throughout the summer and we reserve the right to adjust our safety protocol as necessary.
